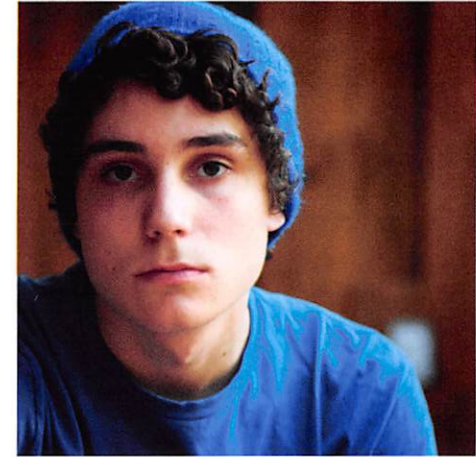
Outpatient Services Serving men, women, teens & families
